

LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY CRICKET CLUB
GROUND REGULATIONS

ADMISSION AND THE RIGHT TO REMAIN WITHIN THE GROUND IS STRICTLY ON CONDITION THAT SPECTATORS SHALL NOT COMMIT ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ACTS:

1. Failing to comply with directions given by a steward, police officer or Club official.
2. Going on to the playing area at any time, unless specifically authorised by a Club official, or interfering with the normal course of play in any manner. Or, Going onto the playing area whilst play is in progress or, interfering with the normal course of play in any manner.
3. Throwing or discharging missiles or causing an affray.
4. Obstructing any gangway, passageway, alleyway or doorway.
5. Climbing on any building, wall or fence.
6. Defacing or obscuring any notice or advertising displayed within Club premises.
7. Failing to take heed to notices displayed at the exits of the premises and buildings
8. Causing nuisance and disturbance to neighbouring premises when leaving the ground.
9. Offering for sale or distributing on the ground newspapers, periodicals or any other articles without written permission from the Chief Executive Officer on behalf of the Board.
10. Interfering in any way with the comfort, enjoyment or safety of spectators including:
 - A) Singing indecent songs or using indecent language or making indecent gestures.
 - B) Making unnecessary noise such as that from the use of radios, whistles, bells, cans or persistently chanting, in any part of the ground.
 - C) Unreasonably obstructing the view of other spectators.
11. The Club reserves the right to
 - A) Close bars at any time and to restrict the consumption of alcohol.
 - B) Refuse admission to any person.
 - C) Prosecute, eject or cause to be ejected by an authorised steward or police officer, anyone contravening these regulations.
12. Members and/or paying spectators are requested not to bring dogs into the ground on match days. The only exception to this shall be the admittance of dogs assisting the blind or handicapped persons.
13. The playing of ball games behind seating areas which inconveniences other spectators is prohibited.
14. Spectators may not without consent remove any seating sited and provided by the Club in order to install personal chairs/seats.
15. **IMPORTATION of ALCOHOL is STRICTLY PROHIBITED for ALL MATCHES.**
16. Spectators will not be permitted to remove glasses or open bottles from the premises.
17. Spectators will ensure that they dispose of any empty bottles and any rubbish in the refuse bins provided.
18. "Spectators shall not engage in any conduct, act towards or speak to any player, umpire, referee or other official or other spectators in a manner which offends, insults, humiliates, intimidates, threatens, disparages or vilifies that other person on the basis of that other person's race, religion, colour, national or ethnic origin.

Spectators are reminded that racially abusive comments and actions will not be tolerated and will result in expulsion from the ground and possible criminal prosecution.

Stewards and Police Officers are authorised to remove from the ground anyone contravening these regulations.

The club reserves the right to refuse admission to any person.

In the case of Fire, spectators are asked to assemble on the playing area and await instructions.

All cars on LCCC grounds are parked at the owners risk.
All spectators should avoid parking on neighbouring streets.
